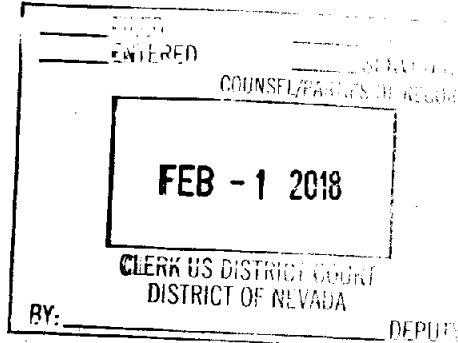

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Petitioner, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC or Commission), under the authority conferred by Section 20 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 57b-1 and Fed. R. Civ. P. 81(a)(5), has invoked the aid of this Court for an order requiring Respondents, Donor Relations, LLC, and Courtesy Call, Inc., to comply with civil investigative demands (CID), issued to them on August 28, 2017, in aid of an FTC law enforcement investigation.

The Court has considered the Federal Trade Commission's Petition to Enforce Civil Investigative Demands and the papers filed in support thereof; and, appearing to the Court that Petitioner has shown good cause for the entry of such order, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Respondents, Donor Relations, LLC, and Courtesy Call, Inc., appear at \_\_\_\_\_ a.m./p.m. on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2017, in Courtroom No. \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lloyd D. George United States Courthouse for the District of Nevada, located at 333 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Las Vegas, Nevada, and show cause, if any there be, why this Court should not grant said Petition and enter an Order enforcing the CIDs. Unless the Court determines otherwise, notwithstanding the filing or pendency of any procedural or other motions, all issues raised by the

1 Petition and supporting papers, and any opposition to the Petition, will be  
2 considered at the hearing on the Petition, and the allegations of the Petition shall  
3 be deemed admitted unless controverted by a specific factual showing; and

4 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, if either Respondent believes it to be  
5 necessary for the Court to hear live testimony, it must file an affidavit reflecting  
6 such testimony (or if a proposed witness is not available to provide such an  
7 affidavit, a specific description of the witness's proposed testimony) and explain why  
8 Respondent believes that live testimony is required; and

9 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, if either Respondent intends to file  
10 pleadings, affidavits, exhibits, motions or other papers in opposition to said Petition  
11 or to the entry of the Order requested therein, such papers must be filed with the  
12 Court and received by Petitioner's counsel on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2017.  
13 Such submission shall include, in the case of any affidavits or exhibits not  
14 previously submitted, or objections not previously made to the Federal Trade  
15 Commission, an explanation as to why such objections were not made or such  
16 papers or information not submitted to the Commission. Any reply by Petitioner  
17 shall be filed with the Court and received by Respondents on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of  
18 \_\_\_\_\_, 2017; and

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 81(a)(5) and  
20 26(a)(1)(B)(v), this is a summary proceeding and no party shall be entitled to  
21 discovery without further order of the Court upon a specific showing of need; and  
22 that the dates for a hearing and the filing of papers established by this Order shall  
23 not be altered without prior order of the Court upon good cause shown; and

1           IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 81(a)(5) and its  
2 1946 advisory committee note, a copy of this Order and copies of said Petition and  
3 exhibits filed therewith, shall be served forthwith by Petitioner upon Respondents  
4 or their counsel, using as expeditious means as practicable.
