ORDER GRANTING FOURTH AGREED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On May 31, 2023, non-parties Sagent M&C, LLC (“Sagent”) and Warburg Pincus, LLC (“Warburg”) filed a fourth motion to extend the time to June 1, 2023, to file a motion to limit or quash or otherwise respond to two individual deposition subpoenas served on Warburg by Respondent Intercontinental Exchange, Inc. (“ICE”) (the “Individual Subpoenas”); and to extend the time to June 2, 2023, to file a motion to limit or quash or otherwise respond to the topics in the corporate representative deposition subpoenas served on Sagent and Warburg by ICE (the “Corporate Subpoenas”) (“Motion”).

The Motion states that negotiations among Sagent, Warburg and ICE as to the scope of Sagent’s and Warburg’s discovery obligations are productive and ongoing and that further negotiations may narrow or eliminate areas of dispute. The Motion further notes that the hearing in this matter is scheduled for July 12, 2023; that Sagent and Warburg substantially completed document productions on May 26, 2023; and that Sagent and Warburg will work cooperatively with ICE to schedule the depositions within a reasonable time. Sagent and Warburg also state that ICE agrees to the requested extension of time and Complaint Counsel does not oppose it.

Upon review and consideration of the Motion, the Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that Sagent’s and Warburg’s deadlines to file a motion to quash or limit or otherwise respond to the Individual Subpoenas and to the Corporate Subpoenas are extended to June 1, 2023 and June 2, 2023, respectively.
