KIDZ SHOULD:

Never give out your last or family name, your home address or your phone number.

Keep your screenname, user ID and password private.

Look at a website's Privacy Policy to see how the site uses the information you give them.

Talk about the site's Privacy Policy with your parents.

Show your parents the sites you visit.

Understand that websites must get your parent's permission before they collect many kinds of information from you.

Leave a site if it makes you uncomfortable or asks for more information than you want to share.

PARENTS SHOULD:

Look for a website's privacy policy.

Read the policy closely to learn the kinds of personal information being collected, how it will be used, and whether it will be passed on to third parties.

Decide whether to let the website collect personal information from your child.

Decide whether to let the website share your child's personal information with others.

Ask to see the information your child has submitted.

Understand that you may revoke your consent at any time and have your child's information deleted.
