

Dear Mr. Mills:

Thank you very much for your letter of June 26 regarding a quote "NPR" relating to the amendments to the Care Labeling Rule. In particular, the section which addresses "Professionally Wet Clean" instructions.

I'm not sure exactly which definition of "Professionally Wet Clean" we are referring to, as there seems to be two or three different possibilities. However, they all seem to be fine with me with the exception of one word in one of the definitions. That word is "agitation."

I would strongly suggest that the word agitation be replaced with "mechanical action." As agitation tends to denote the agitation as in top loader -- home style -- type washing machine.

The mechanical action in a front loader washer-extractor should not be described as agitation. But in a top loader, the mechanical action generated is commonly referred to as agitation.

Other than that, the definitions work well for us.
