

Did You Buy Xenadrine EFX?

You May Be Eligible For A Refund



To settle a dispute over advertising claims with the Federal Trade Commission, the marketers of Xenadrine EFX are offering you a refund if you are **NOT SATISFIED** with the Xenadrine EFX you bought. If you are **SATISFIED** with the Xenadrine EFX you bought, please disregard this refund offer.

In July 2005, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) filed a complaint in federal court against the marketers of Xenadrine EFX, including Robert Chinery, Jr. and RTC Research & Development, LLC. The FTC alleged that Xenadrine EFX's marketers made deceptive claims about the product's ability to cause weight loss. Xenadrine EFX's marketers have denied the charges, but have agreed to a settlement order and promised to make refunds for eligible purchases to dissatisfied customers.

All claim forms **must be received** by the Claims Administrator no later than September 15, 2007 to be eligible for a refund. The amount of your refund depends on the number of consumers who participate in this offer.
