RE: Business Opportunity Rule, R511993

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing this letter because I am deeply concerned about the proposed Business Opportunity Rule R511993. I sincerely believe that in its current form, it could prevent me from continuing to conduct business as a Distributor for Xango and could very well destroy my home business

I have been an Independent Distributor for Xango for about a year and a half now and consider my home business to be my vehicle to financial freedom and stability over the next decade or more. I began my home business because it gives me the time freedom and schedule flexibility that is not available to me through a corporate 9-5 job. It also allows me to the unlimited potential to make more money to pay my bills off and give back to charitable organizations and causes than I ever could with a "regular" job. It also, very importantly gives me the ability to take my business on the road so that I can leave Massachusetts and travel to spend more quality time with my 83 year old Mom in Florida during the Winter months, something I also could not do with a corporate job part of the year.

I originally started my Network Marketing business because of the opportunity to earn a great deal of extra income and to learn more sales and management skills. However, since my company's product is in the health and wellness arena and is very effective in helping people with various health challenges, I have been blessed with the opportunity to help hundreds of people live healthier lives and rid themselves of chronic health problems that have often plagued them for years. Now I depend on my income to live on and my customers depend on my product to live healthier lives. Please do NOT destroy my small business as I depend on it for survival as do many other people!!! I love my business, my product, my company and the people on my team and want us all to be able to continue to do business simply and effectively for many more years!

Some of the conditions in the proposed rule would make it difficult or almost impossible for me to sell Xango's products. The waiting period will give the public the idea that there is something wrong with me as a business person or our make people think our company is not a legitimate and successful entity which also reflects poorly on me. I also think the 7-day waiting period is unnecessary, because Xango already has a 90% buyback policy for all products including sales kits purchased by a distributor.

One of the most difficult sections of the proposed rule is this 7-day waiting period to enroll a new Xango distributor. Our company's sales kit only costs \$35. People buy TV's, cars and

other items that cost thousands of dollars and they don't have to wait 7 days. Under this waiting period requirement, I will need to keep very detailed records when I first speak to someone, and filing the Disclosure Form itself will generate tons of paper that legitimate small home businesses such as mine will have to deal with. In a period filled with such large Federal deficits it will add more "paper pushers" in Washington just to catch the few crooks out there. The Disclosure Form requirement will cause unnecessary delays for good people.

Finally, the proposed rule requires the disclosure of a minimum of 10 prior purchasers nearest to the prospective purchaser. I am glad to provide references, but in a time when identity theft is running rampant, I am extremely uncomfortable giving out the personal information of individuals (without their approval) to strangers. Women in my organization may be subject to sexual or racial harassment so this part can't go in at all, unless the FTC passes an addition to this rule prohibiting sexual or racial attacks related to this disclosure. In the end the rule must bind the FTC to take direct enforcement action on sexual and racial attacks with a special unit assigned to monitor actions related to the Disclosure Forms.

I have seen many scams on the Internet and been approached by many crooks due to my success. This rule will do NOTHING to stop them. They hurt my business! This rule will NOT stop crooks! They violate the current rule all the time. I am a good American citizen and it WILL HURT ME!! Please help me and others like me by not passing this rule. Thank you for listening.
