They helped me to increase my income as well as my knowledge. Through Quixtar I had learnt how to live better, improve my health, improve communication skill with people, build my self-confidence. I wish I would meet my goal of Diamond Level in Quixtar business so that I will enjoy a totally free life. But I found that what I had gained was much more than what I had made.

Before I register, I received a very sufficient information about the company, the products as well as business opportunity. When I sponsor others, I provide them with the same information and make sure they understand Quixtar business is not a guaranteed success business, which needs hard working and a heart of sincere concern about others. When my prospects register, as well as myself, we pay the registration fee (presently \$51.50) and we know that no purchase is necessary to register and we can enjoy free refund in 180 days on most products plus we can cancel our membership any time without penalty.

To my understanding the proposed rules contain some requirements that are not fair to IBOs:

1. The 7-days wait rule and references providing – most prospects join Quixtar are interesting in the products at the beginning. As an IBO, he/she can enjoy a remarkable discount on products. Imagine, if anybody wants to go shopping in a mall, who is going to wait 7 days? Plus they will receive a list of people that they don't even know before they can go shopping? How would somebody like that his/her name, address, phone numbers is given away to stranger? I think this rule is non-sense. That will make a huge affect on any IBO's business. Who will become an IBO if they know that their privacy will be exposed to the public? This rule is definitely against anybody's personal privacy.
2. Provide a litigation list – I think that is unfair to Quixtar and any IBO on this case. As we know, companies, organizations, even U.S. government departments may receive various litigation or complaints for different issues. However, these do not necessary mean that they had done anything wrong. Especially this rule, the period required within 10 years. That is absolutely a mislead to anyone who wants to enjoy a better products and it may ruin a person's possible way to success.
3. Financial substantiation – If anyone asked me about my income information from Quixtar business, I will tell them what reward level I am at and what my goal will be. In Quixtar, everyone's goal may be different. Some may look for a better health or a lifestyle. Others may look for beauty, still there are others like to improve their communication skill. In Quixtar business, nobody will make the same money. IBO did not required to do any business when they registered. They understand that money comes with effort. They have been informed of the reward system. More they work more they make. Therefore, I think this rule is inappropriate for that would only mislead the others. Again, I strongly believe it is against the constitution of the "privacy rule"
