

I would like to make a few comments on the Act.

Regarding section 315.2 which defines the contact lens prescription, the definition should include the quantity of lenses dispensed. If the prescription verification request comes to the prescriber on the day before the prescription expires, the prescriber should be obligated, in the interest of patient safety, to limit the quantity to a reasonable time frame.

The commission should absolutely define non-corrective and cosmetic lenses as contact lenses since they are in fact "contact" lenses and are just as potentially hazzards to eye health as prescription lenses. I have seen numerous eye injuries and infections that arose from the purchase of cosmetic contacts from places like hairdressers and tatoos parlors. Regulation of these lenses is clearly an important eye health issue.
