Please support the new contact lens law. I have worn contact lenses for 22 years now, and I love the easy access to lenses that is now in existence. I would like it to continue. As a mother of 3 young children, it is so much easier to order lenses online or over the phone and have them delivered to my door than it is to go to a vision store. I do regularly go to my ophthalmologist every two years for an eye checkup and new prescription for my lenses, which my online supplier verifies each time I order. I do not think that obtaining lenses in this fashion is at all dangerous to my health. If I wanted to change types of lenses for any reason, then I would have to get sample lenses from either my eye doctor or a local vision center, but having worn the same lenses for many years now, that is an unnecessary hassle.

Therefore, I'm asking you to please support the new contact lens law, and do not revise it in any way.
