Dear Sir or Madam:

Your proposed rule, which as I understand it, would require me to wait days to receive a contact lens order instead or almost immediately or at most a few hours, would place a totally absurd waiting time to receive contact lenses. If I were using my last pair and for some reason could not get to an optician before the time expired beyond which I should remove my lenses or risk eye damage, at best I would be inconvenienced by possibly having to make a return trip to my optician, forced to wear possibly outdated glasses which could impair my ability to drive and conduct normal daily business, and at work could risk damaging my eyes.

I urge your agency to discard this proposed rule.
