I am writing to urge you to do away with changes in the law, which would make consumers wait, before having their contact lenses shipped. I should have the right to buy lenses to help me SEE, and have access to those lenses immediately. They are a necessary commodity, not a luxury item... and it affects my safety and others, especially when I am driving on the road. Glasses do not correct my vision as well as contacts do. My job as an on-air broadcaster also requires me to wear contacts, because studio lights are reflected in glasses' lenses. It is more than an inconvenience to have to wait for contacts... it is an unreasonable condition that infringes on my rights and my safety. I implore you to let consumers, who have already had to wait for a doctor's appointment to get an exam in the first place... have their contacts in a timely manner.
