To the Federal Trade Commission:

I have been informed by my contact lens provider that you are considering a rule that would limit my ability to obtain lenses, and I would like to add my comments to the public record for your consideration.

It is important to me to have the freedom to obtain my lenses quickly and easily. I tore a lens while traveling on an extended trip last summer, and 1-800-CONTACTS had my prescription on file and was able to send a replacement the next day. I cannot imagine getting the same level of service from my doctor's office, especially on a weekend.

If there is a legitimate reason to limit trade in this industry, please let me know, as I would like to be fully informed. Based on my current knowledge of the circumstances, I urge you to avoid rules that would limit my ability to obtain products that I need.
