One of the advantages is that I can get a lens if I lose or tear one by the next day. My eyes are bad enough that I cannot drive without them and I find using glasses just doesn't work for me.

Please reconsider this legislation. I'm not sure what your reason for it is, but I can't think of anything that would make this ruling necessary.
