I am in receipt of a letter from Contacts.com outlining the above referenced act and am deeply concerned by this for the following reason. I go to a private eye doctor who has prescribed a prescription for both my contacts and back up glasses. He has a large sign on the counter in his office (no one could miss it) that states that he charges \$50.00 for a copy of your prescription. If you come in for an office visit and your prescription changes, the \$50.00 fee is in addition to your office visit fee of over \$100.00. Fortunately for me my prescription has not changed since this sign went up and since I only see him every 2 years, these charges have not affected me. However - I am appalled that he and other doctors feel they have the right to do this and hope that he can be notified directly by someone of authority.

I have not been to his office in about 2 months, so I do not know if the sign has been removed since then. Please let me know if you would like his direct contact information.
