Subject: Fast Shipping is Fundamental

Dear FTC:

I recently learned that a proposed FTC rule could make contact lens wearers have to wait several days before their contact lenses can be shipped. As someone who fully supports any and all rules and regulations which make it easy for contact lens wearers to receive a copy of their contact lens prescription from their eye doctor, it only makes sense that I am in favor of no delay whatsoever in allowing shipping of contact lenses to those wearers, from whatever source.

I have been wearing contact lenses since I was sixteen, and have consistently sought out any and all ways to make the eye exam, contact lens prescription and shipping process as convenient as possible. I therefore now obtain my lens prescription from a place like Nuvision, and then order my lenses through an online internet service. The reason is that, like most people these days, I work more hours in the week than ever before, and I desperately want to conserve as much of my free time as possible for things more meaningful than waiting for my contact lenses to arrive. We are for good reason an Internet Nation these days, and it would be a shame to go backwards 20 years by not allowing the fast and easy shipping of contact lenses to the wearers.
