Subject: Contact lens rule

I am a consumer and user of contact lenes. I support the the New Contact Lens Law! Without a prescription from my Ophthamologist to use in the purchase of my lenses, from another source I would be forced to buy them from the Ophthamologist at a higher cost. Dependent on the lens it can mean up to a fifty per cent savings. I replace my lenes about five times a year so the cost savings adds up. Health care of any kind is not cheap to force the consumer to pay a higher price for lenses should not be acceptable. Nor should the Federal Trade Commission restrct the trade of lens providers when they are providing a valuable service and do so by confirming the lens perscription with the eye specialist. The company I deal with 1-800-CONTACTS has not and will not refill my perscription without my Ophthamologist authorization.
