As a contact lens wearer, it has made my relationship with my ophthalmologist uncomfortable when I needed to ask him/her for a copy of my prescription.. I requested the same so that I may receive more competitive pricing and convenience when purchasing new lenses, or re-newing existing prescriptions.

Since they are often wish to supply me with lenses (at considerable margins over their competitors) it is difficult to maintain a caring doctor-patient relationship when I say "no", I am not interested in purchasing lenses from you.

I support the New Contact Lens Consumers Act of 2003 and think it only fair that s/he provide me with a copy of my prescription whether I ask for one or not. The eye professional should focus on medical care and not on profiting from suggesting "new" or different versions of lenses.
