Subject: BURR BILL

Dear FTC -

The BURR BILL is seriously flawed. By only requiring 8 hours verification, and not requiring positive verification of Rx's, you are allowing the sale of illegal medical devices to the public.

Let's apply this to two other situations ...

1) A website starts selling prescription drugs on the internet, and you are a medical doctor in surgery ... 8 hours elapses and the internet site sells the Rx drugs without an valid Rx to your patient ... allowing them to selfmedicate.

2) Your 16 year old daughter goes in to have a tatoo, piercing, and an abortion at HackJob Inc. They send you a fax saying you as a parent have 8 hours to respond and refuse to allow treatment. You are in a business meeting all day, so they do the procedures anyway without your consent.

This is how stupid the flawed BURR BILL is. POSITIVE VERIFICATION should be required for medical devices just like Rx drugs and procedures on minors.
