I am writing to urge the Federal Trade Commission **NOT** to weaken the Do-Not-Call Registry by allowing telemarketers to use pre-recorded messages to contact customers.

The Do-Not-Call Registry has been a godsend, and has dramatically reduced the number of annoying telemarketing calls, SPAM faxes and other extreme annoyances. Just today, in fact, I filed an online complaint about a pre-recorded telemarketing call I received. I sincerely dread the day such calls become legal.

Please do **NOT** allow the telemarketing industry to prey upon consumers. Do **NOT** cave in to their lobbying pressure.
