

RE: Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act Privacy Rule, 16 CFR Part 313-Comment

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I am writing to express my concern with the proposed regulations to implement Title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act of 1999. I am submitting these comments on behalf of the Maryland State Investigators and Security Association, PMB 363, 2043 East Joppa Road, Baltimore, Maryland 21234. Our is a state organization representing hundreds of licensed private investigators that stand to lose a valuable tool if "non-public personal information" is defined to include simple names and addresses of customers of financial institutions. Nothing in the consideration of privacy during congressional debate reflected concern about name and address information. Rather, the clear intent of Congress was to provide an opportunity for customers of financial institutions to "opt out" of sharing their personal financial information.
