# COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF ITS MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

On July 25, 2003 Complaint Counsel filed a Motion to Consolidate pursuant to § 3.41(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. That motion sought consolidation of: In

the Matter of Alabama Trucking Association, Inc., Docket No. 9307; In the Matter of Movers Conference of Mississippi, Inc., Docket No. 9308; and In the Matter of Kentucky Household Goods Carriers Association, Inc., Docket No. 9309. Respondent Kentucky Household Goods Carriers Association opposed that motion. Complaint Counsel's reply to that opposition noted that Complaint Counsel's motion may become moot because the Alabama Trucking Association (Docket No. 9307) and the Movers Conference of Mississippi (Docket No. 9308) were engaged in settlement discussions. On August 12, 2003 the Secretary of the Commission removed the Movers Conference of Mississippi, Inc. matter (Docket 9308) from litigation to consider a proposed consent agreement. Similarly, on August 29, 2003 the Secretary of the Commission removed the Alabama Trucking Association (Docket 9307) from litigation for the same reason. On October 30, 2003 the Commission announced that it had provisionally accepted those consents. Given these settlement agreements and considering that the remaining matter is proceeding apace, Complaint Counsel hereby withdraws its Motion to Consolidate. Respondent's Counsel has indicated that it has no objection to this withdrawal. A proposed order is attached.
