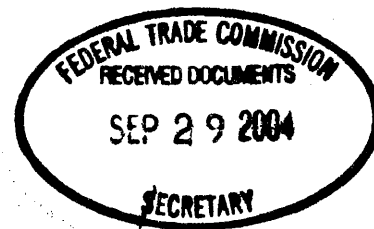

REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER


On September 29, 2004, the parties filed a joint motion to modify the deadlines in the Revised Scheduling Order relating to the exchange of designated deposition testimony.

The joint motion is GRANTED. The Scheduling Order in this matter is revised as follows:

- October 4, 2004 - Complaint Counsel and Respondent exchange designated testimony which each party intends to present by deposition.
- October 11, 2004 - Exchange objections to the designated testimony to be presented by deposition and counter-designations.
- October 15, 2004 - Exchange objections to counter-designations.

This Order does not affect any other deadlines set forth in the current Revised Scheduling Order.
