**ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION
OF NON-PARTY SIGMA CORPORATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On March 29, 2012, non-party Sigma Corporation (“Sigma”) filed its second unopposed motion to extend the time for Sigma to move to limit or quash (1) the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it on February 16, 2012 by Respondent McWane, Inc. (“McWane”), and (2) the Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* that McWane served on it on February 17, 2012 (collectively, the “Subpoenas”).

By Order dated March 1, 2012, Sigma was previously granted an extension of time to move to limit or quash the Subpoenas through March 30, 2012.

In support of its motion, Sigma states that the parties are in the process of conferring about the Subpoenas and that McWane does not oppose an extension through April 6, 2012 for Sigma to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoenas, while the parties negotiate in good faith to limit the Subpoenas issued to Sigma and its employees. Sigma further states that it expressly reserves the right to argue that service of certain of these subpoenas may be defective because Sigma does not have control of some of the individuals identified in the Subpoenas.

Accordingly, based on the foregoing, the Second Unopposed Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for non-party Sigma Corporation to file any motion to limit or quash the Subpoenas shall be April 6, 2012.
