The Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition has conducted a non-public investigation to determine whether the acquisition by Monster Worldwide, Inc. ("Monster") of HotJobs.com, Ltd. ("HotJobs"), from Yahoo!, Inc. may violate Section 7 of the Clayton Act or Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act.

Upon further review of this matter, it now appears that no additional action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly, the investigation has been closed. This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation may not have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that a violation has occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take further action as the public interest may require.
