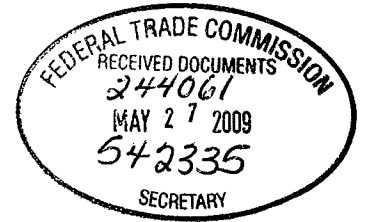


**ORDER ON NON-PARTY ERIC HEGLIE'S  
MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA AD TESTIFICANDUM**

On May 26, 2009, non-party Eric Heglie ("Heglie") submitted a motion to quash the subpoena *ad testificandum* served on him by Respondent. Heglie asserts that he previously provided testimony at an investigational hearing and at a deposition at which all parties were represented. He further asserts that requiring his appearance would be unduly burdensome and his testimony at trial would be needlessly cumulative.

Trial in this matter is currently proceeding. On May 27, 2009, in open court, the parties agreed to allow Heglie to appear through his previous testimony and Respondent agreed to withdraw this subpoena.

Accordingly, Heglie's motion to quash is DENIED AS MOOT.
