TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER WITH ASSET FREEZE, ORDER PERMITTING EXPEDITED DISCOVERY, AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION SHOULD NOT ISSUE

Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission ("FTC"), having filed its Complaint for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief pursuant to Sections 5(a) and 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. §§ 45(a) and 53(b), and the Telemarketing Sales Rule, 16 C.F.R. Part 310, and having moved *ex parte* for a Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause why a Preliminary Injunction

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER WITH ASSET FREEZE, ORDER PERMITTING EXPEDITED DISCOVERY, AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION SHOULD NOT ISSUE

Should Not Issue pursuant to Rule 65(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, and the Court, having considered the Complaint, declarations, appendices, and memorandum of points and authorities filed in support thereof, and now being advised in the premises, finds that:

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this case, and there is good cause to believe it will have jurisdiction of all parties hereto;
- 2. There is good cause to believe that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling has engaged in an is likely to engage in acts and practices that violate Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), and the Telemarketing Sales Rule, 16 C.F.R. Part 310, and that Plaintiff is therefore likely to prevail on the merits of this action;
- 3. There is good cause to believe that immediate and irreparable damage to the Court's ability to grant effective final relief for consumers in the form of monetary restitution will occur from the sale, transfer, or other disposition or concealment by Defendant of his assets or company records, or those assets and company records under his control, unless Defendant is immediately restrained and enjoined by Order of this Court. Such injury is so imminent that notice and a hearing on this Motion for Temporary Restraining Order is impractical, if not impossible. There is thus good cause for issuing this Order without prior notice pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(b);
- 4. Weighing the equities and considering Plaintiff's likelihood of ultimate success on the merits, a Temporary Restraining Order with asset freeze and other

equitable relief is in the public interest; and

5. Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c) does not require security of the United States or an officer or agency thereof.

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Temporary Restraining Order ("Order"), the following definitions shall apply:

- A. "Defendant" means Steven Anthony Breitling individually and doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co.), and Integrated Credit Services.
- B. "Assets" means any legal or equitable interest in, right to, or claim to, any real and personal property, including, but not limited to, "goods," "instruments," "equipment," "fixtures," "general intangibles," "inventory," "checks," "notes" (as these terms are defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), and all chattel, leaseholds, contracts, mail or other deliveries, shares of stock, lists of consumer names, accounts, credits, premises, receivables, funds, and cash, wherever located.
- C. "Assisting others" means knowingly providing any of the following goods or services to another entity: (1) performing customer service functions, including, but not limited to, receiving or responding to consumer complaints; (2) formulating or providing, or arranging for the formulation or provision of, any marketing material; (3) providing names of, or assisting in the generation of, potential customers; or (4) performing

marketing or billing services of any kind.

D. "Document" is synonymous in meaning and equal in scope to the usage of the term in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 34(a), and includes writings, drawings, graphs, charts, photographs, audio and video recordings, computer records, and other data compilations from which the information can be obtained and translated, if necessary, through detection devices into reasonably usable form. A draft or non-identical copy is a separate document within the meaning of the term.

ORDER

CONDUCT PROHIBITIONS

I. INJUNCTION AGAINST MISREPRESENTATIONS

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that in connection with the marketing or offering to arrange loans or other extensions of credit, Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling, doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns, members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, affiliate or other device, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from misrepresenting or assisting others in misrepresenting, either orally or in writing, expressly or by implication, any material fact, including, but not limited to:

- A. Consumers are "approved," "pre-approved," or "guaranteed" for loans or other extensions of credit, or otherwise have a high likelihood of success in obtaining a loan or other extension of credit; and
- B. Defendant will have a high likelihood of success in obtaining or arranging a loan or other extension of credit for consumers.

II. INJUNCTION AGAINST VIOLATIONS OF THE TELEMARKETING SALES RULE

to arrange loans or other extensions of credit, Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling, doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co.), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns, members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, affiliate or other device, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from failing to follow the provisions of the Telemarketing Sales Rule, 16 C.F.R. Part 310, including, but not limited to, the prohibition against requesting or receiving payment of any fee or consideration in advance of obtaining a loan or other extension of credit when Defendant has guaranteed or represented a high likelihood of success in obtaining or arranging a loan or other extension of credit for a person.

III. PLAINTIFF'S ACCESS TO DEFENDANT'S DOCUMENTS AND DATA

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling shall, within forty-eight (48) hours of service of this Order, produce for inventory and copying to Plaintiff at the Office of the United States Attorney for the Western District of Oklahoma, located at 210 West Park Avenue, Suite 400, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73102, or other mutually agreeable location, all correspondence, email, financial data, electronically stored information, or any other documents and computer equipment, in Defendant's possession, custody, or control, containing information about Defendant's business and assets.

Plaintiff shall return any such documents or computer equipment to Defendant within seven (7) business days of completing inventory and copying. Defendant, to the extent he is in possession, custody, or control of documents, computer equipment, or electronically stored information relevant to this action, shall provide Plaintiff with any necessary means of access to the documents, computer equipment, or electronically stored information, including, but not limited to, computer access codes and passwords.

ASSET & RECORD RETENTION

IV. ASSET FREEZE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling, doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co.), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns,

members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, affiliate or other device, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from:

- A. Transferring, converting, encumbering, selling, concealing, dissipating, disbursing, assigning, spending, withdrawing, perfecting a security interest in, or otherwise disposing of any funds, real or personal property, accounts, contracts, shares of stock, lists of consumer names, or other assets, wherever located, including outside the United States, that are:
 - Owned or controlled by, or held for the benefit of, directly or indirectly, Defendant, in whole or in part;
 - 2. In the actual or constructive possession of Defendant;
 - Held by an agent of Defendant as a retainer for the agent's provision of services to Defendant; or
 - 4. Owned or controlled by, or in the actual or constructive possession of or otherwise held for the benefit of, any corporation, partnership, or other entity directly or indirectly owned, managed, or controlled by Defendant, including, but not limited to, any assets held by, for, or subject to access by, Defendant at any bank or savings and loan institution, or with any broker-dealer, escrow agent, title company,

commodity trading company, precious metal dealer, or other financial institution or depository of any kind;

- B. Opening or causing to be opened any safe deposit boxes titled in
 Defendant's name, or subject to access by Defendant;
- C. Obtaining a personal or secured loan encumbering Defendant's assets, or subject to access by Defendant;
- D. Incurring liens or other encumbrances on real property, personal property, or other assets in the name, singly or jointly, of Defendant or of any corporation, partnership, or other entity directly or indirectly owned, managed, or controlled by Defendant; or
- E. Incurring charges or cash advances on any credit card or pre-paid debit, credit, or other bank card, issued in the name, singly or jointly, of Defendant or any corporation, partnership, or other entity directly or indirectly owned, managed, or controlled by Defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the assets affected by this Paragraph shall include both existing assets and assets acquired after the effective date of this Order.

V. DUTIES OF ASSET HOLDERS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any financial or brokerage institution,
business entity, or person served with a copy of this Order that holds, controls, or
maintains custody of any account or asset of Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling or has

held, controlled, or maintained custody of any such account or asset at any time since the date of entry of this Order shall:

- A. Hold and retain within its control and prohibit the withdrawal, removal, assignment, transfer, pledge, encumbrance, disbursement, dissipation, conversion, sale, or other disposal of any such asset except by further order of this Court;
- B. Deny Defendant access to any safe deposit box that is:
 - 1. Titled in the name of Defendant, either individually or jointly; or
 - 2. Otherwise subject to access by Defendant;
- C. Provide the FTC's counsel, within five (5) business days of receiving a copy of this Order, a sworn statement setting forth:
 - The identification number of each account or asset titled in the name, individually or jointly, of Defendant, or held on behalf of, or for the benefit of, Defendant.
 - 2. The balance of each account, or a description of the nature and value of the asset(s) as of the close of business on the day on which this Order is served, and, if the account or other asset has been closed or removed, the date closed or removed, the total funds removed in order to close the account, and the name of the person or entity to whom such account or other asset was remitted.

- 3. The identification of any safe deposit box that is either titled in the name, individually or jointly, of Defendant, or is otherwise subject to access by Defendant; and
- D. Upon the request of FTC counsel, promptly provide FTC counsel with copies of all records or other documentation pertaining to such account or asset, including, but not limited to, originals or copies of account applications, account statements, signature cards, checks, drafts, deposit tickets, transfers to and from the accounts, all other debit and credit instruments or slips, currency transaction reports, 1099 forms, and safe deposit box logs. Any such financial institution, account custodian, or other aforementioned entity may arrange for the Commission to obtain copies of any such records which the Commission seeks.

VI. REPATRIATION OF ASSETS AND DOCUMENTS LOCATED IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling, doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns, members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division,

affiliate or other device, shall:

- A. Within three (3) business days following the service of this Order, take such steps as are necessary to transfer to the territory of the United States of America all documents and assets that are located outside of such territory and are held by or for Defendant or are under Defendant's direct or indirect control, jointly, severally, or individually;
- B. Within three (3) business days following service of this Order, provide

 Plaintiff with a full accounting of all documents and assets that are located outside of the territory of the United States of America and are held by or for Defendant or are under Defendant's direct or indirect control, jointly, severally, or individually;
- C. Hold and retain all transferred documents and assets and prevent any transfer, disposition, or dissipation whatsoever of any such assets or funds; and
- D. Provide Plaintiff access to Defendant's records and documents held by
 financial institutions outside the territorial United States, by signing the
 Consent to Release of Financial Records attached hereto at Attachment A.

VII. INTERFERENCE WITH REPATRIATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling, doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A

Financial Co), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns, members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, affiliate or other device, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from taking any action, directly or indirectly, which may result in the encumbrance or dissipation of foreign assets, or in the hindrance of the repatriation required by Paragraph V of this Order, including, but not limited to:

- A. Sending any statement, letter, fax, email or wire transmission, telephoning, or engaging in any other act, directly or indirectly, that results in a determination by a foreign trustee or other entity that a "duress" event has occurred under the terms of a foreign trust agreement until such time as all assets have been fully repatriated pursuant to Paragraph V of this Order; or
- B. Notifying any trustee, protector or other agent of Defendant of the existence of this Order, or of the fact that repatriation is required pursuant to a Court Order, until such time as all assets have been fully repatriated pursuant to Paragraph V of this Order.

VIII. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that not less than three (3) business days prior to the scheduled date and time for the hearing on a preliminary injunction, but in no event later than ten (10) business days after entry of this Order, Defendant Steven Anthony
Breitling shall provide the Commission with completed financial statements, on the forms
attached to this Order as **Attachments B** and **C**, for Defendant individually and for any
corporation, limited liability company, or other entity of which Defendant is an officer,
member, or otherwise directs and/or controls, as of the date of service of this Order upon
Defendant.

IX. CONSUMER CREDIT REPORTS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Section 604(1) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1681b(1), any consumer reporting agency may furnish a consumer report concerning Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling to the Commission.

X. PRESERVATION OF RECORDS

business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns, members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, affiliate or other device, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from destroying, erasing, mutilating, concealing, altering, transferring, or otherwise disposing of, in any manner, directly or indirectly, any contracts, accounting data, correspondence, email,

advertisements, computer tapes, discs, or other computerized storage media, books, written or printed records, handwritten notes, telephone logs, telephone scripts, recordings, receipt books, ledgers, personal and business cancelled checks and check registers, bank statements, appointment books, copies of federal, state or local business or personal income or property tax returns, and other documents or records of any kind that relate to the business practices or business or personal finances of Defendant.

XI. MAINTENANCE OF CURRENT BUSINESS RECORDS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling, doing business as ICS Financial Group, ICS Financial Firm, ICS Financial Services, ICS (A Financial Co.), and Integrated Credit Services, and each of his successors, assigns, members, officers, agents, servants, employees, and those persons in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, affiliate or other device, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from:

- A. Failing to create and maintain documents that, in reasonable detail, accurately, fairly, and completely reflect Defendant's income, disbursements, transactions, and use of money; and
- B. Creating, operating, or exercising any control over any business entity, including any partnership, limited partnership, joint venture, sole proprietorship, corporation, or limited liability company, without first

providing the Commission with a written statement disclosing: (1) the name of the business entity; (2) the address and telephone number of the business entity; (3) the names of the business entity's officer, directors, principals, managers, and employees; and (4) a detailed description of the business entity's intended activities.

XII. DUTIES OF HOSTS OF DEFENDANT'S COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any person who owns or controls any business premises or other location on which any computer equipment owned or leased by Defendant is located shall:

- A. Disconnect any such computer equipment from the Internet and from any other means of remote access by Defendant or any other person, and take no steps to reconnect the computer equipment except as authorized by further Order of this Court;
- B. Deny Defendant and any other person access to the computer equipment except as authorized by a further Order of this Court;
- C. Prevent the removal of the computer equipment from its present location except as authorized by further Order of this Court; and
- D. Provide counsel for the Commission, within five (5) business days of receipt of a copy of this Order, with a sworn statement disclosing the location of the computer equipment, and describing, to the extent known,

the make(s) and model(s) of the computer equipment, as well as the operating system(s) in use, and the number, size, and capacity of any mass storage arrays or devices, in order that the Commission may arrange for imaging of the contents of any such mass storage arrays or devices.

NOTIFICATION PROVISION

XIII. DISTRIBUTION OF ORDER BY DEFENDANT

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Steven Anthony Breitling shall immediately provide a copy of this Order to each affiliate, sales entity, successor, assign, member, officer, employee, agent, servant, attorney, subsidiary, division, and representative of Defendant, and shall, within ten (10) business days from the date of entry of this Order, provide the Commission with a sworn statement that Defendant has complied with this provision of this Order, which statement shall include the names and addresses of each such person or entity who received a copy of this Order.

XIV. SERVICE OF ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Order may be served by any means, including facsimile transmission, email, and overnight delivery service, upon any financial institution or other entity or person that may have possession, custody, or control of any documents or assets of Defendant, or that may be subject to any provision of this Order. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c)(2), this Order and the initial papers filed in this matter may be served on Defendant, upon the business premises of Defendant, and upon

any financial institution or other entity or person that may have possession, custody, or control of any documents or assets of Defendant, or that may be subject to any provision of this Order, by employees of the Commission, by employees of any other law enforcement agency, by any agent of Plaintiff or by any agent of any process service retained by Plaintiff.

XV. MONITORING

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that agents or representatives of the Commission may contact Defendant or Defendant's agents or representatives directly and anonymously for the purpose of monitoring compliance with Paragraphs I and II of this Order, and may tape record any oral communications that occur in the course of such contacts.

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION PROCEEDINGS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall serve upon the opposing party

XVI. SERVICE OF PLEADINGS

and the Court and file all memoranda, affidavits, and other evidence upon which they intend to rely at the preliminary injunction hearing set in this matter not later than 2:00 p.m. CDT of the second day prior to the hearing date. Service on the Commission shall be performed by delivery to the attention of Emily B. Robinson at the Federal Trade Commission, Southwest Region, 1999 Bryan Street, Suite 2150, Dallas, Texas 75201-6803, or by facsimile transmission to (214) 953-3079.

XVII. EXAMINATION OF WITNESSES

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this preliminary injunction hearing will be conducted on the papers served and filed by the parties and on oral argument by counsel.

So live witness testimony will be heard.

XVIII. EXPEDITED ASSET DISCOVERY

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in anticipation of the preliminary injunction hearing set herein, the Commission is granted leave to conduct expedited discovery regarding Defendant's assets. The Commission may depose any witness regarding Defendant's assets at any time after the date of this Order upon three (3) business days' notice. Defendant shall respond to any asset-related interrogatories, requests for admissions, or requests for production of documents within four (4) business days after service of the discovery request. Any discovery taken or propounded by the Commission pursuant to this Paragraph is in addition to, and not subject to, any limits on the quantity of permissible discovery provided for in the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure or the rules of this Court. Any limitations and conditions set forth in the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure or the rules of this Court regarding subsequent depositions of an individual shall not apply to depositions taken pursuant to this Paragraph.

XIX. ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

shall appear before this Court on the Alst day of May, 2008, at 10 o'clock

Q. m. CDT at the United States District Court, Western District of Oklahoma, located at QOO N. W. 4th Street, Oklahoma City, X, to show cause, if there is any, why this Court should not enter a preliminary injunction, pending final ruling on the Complaint against Defendant, enjoining him from further violations of Section 5(a) of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), and the Telemarketing Sales Rule, 16 C.F.R. Part 310, continuing the freeze of his assets, and imposing such additional relief as may be appropriate.

XX. DURATION OF TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

on May 21, 2008, at 10:00a.m. CDT, unless before such time, the Order is extended for good cause shown, or by consent of the parties.

XXI. RETENTION OF JURISDICTION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes.

- 5. Type or print legibly.
- 6. Initial each page in the space provided in the lower right corner.
- 7. Sign and date the completed financial statement on the last page.

Penalty for False Information:

Federal law provides that any person may be imprisoned for not more than five years, fined, or both, if such person:

- (1) "in any matter within the jurisdiction of any department or agency of the United States knowingly and willfully falsifies, conceals or covers up by any trick, scheme, or device a material fact, or makes any false, fictitious or fraudulent statements or representations, or makes or uses any false writing or document knowing the same to contain any false, fictitious or fraudulent statement or entry" (18 U.S.C. § 1001);
- (2) "in any . . . statement under penalty of perjury as permitted under section 1746 of title 28, United States Code, willfully subscribes as true any material matter which he does not believe to be true" (18 U.S.C. § 1621); or
- (3) "in any (... statement under penalty of perjury as permitted under section 1746 of title 28, United States Code) in any proceeding before or ancillary to any court or grand jury of the United States knowingly makes any false material declaration or makes or uses any other information . . . knowing the same to contain any false material declaration" (18 U.S.C. § 1623).

For a felony conviction under the provisions cited above, federal law provides that the fine may be not more than the greater of (i) \$250,000 for an individual or \$500,000 for a corporation, or (ii) if the felony results in pecuniary gain to any person or pecuniary loss to any person other than the defendant, the greater of twice the gross gain or twice the gross loss. 18 U.S.C. § 3571.
