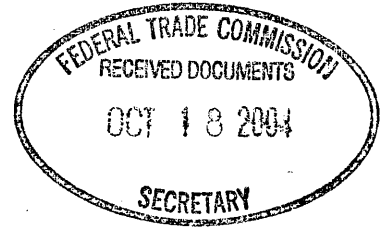



**ORDER REQUIRING EXPEDITED RESPONSE**

On October 15, 2004, Complaint Counsel filed an unopposed motion for extension of time to file responses to Respondent Daniel B. Mowrey's First Set of Interrogatories and Requests for Admissions, requesting an extension from October 21, 2004 to October 29, 2004. Complaint Counsel contends that the extension is necessary based upon the hospitalization of an attorney, jury duty of another attorney, and other deadlines in this proceeding. Complaint Counsel represents that counsel for Respondent Mowrey does not oppose the requested extension.
