RESPONDENT JOHN FANNING'S OBJECTION TO COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S EXHIBIT LIST

Respondent John Fanning hereby generally objects to Complaint Counsel's proposed exhibit list. For the same reasons expressed in Mr. Fanning's pending motions *in limine* and motion to strike Complaint Counsel's final proposed witness list, Mr. Fanning objects to any exhibits that seek to inject unreliable, irrelevant, immaterial, cumulative, and unduly prejudicial information into the trial of this action. In particular, 16 CFR §3.43(b) instructs:

Relevant, material, and reliable evidence shall be admitted. Irrelevant, immaterial, and unreliable evidence shall be excluded. Evidence, even if relevant, may be excluded if its probative value is substantially outweighed by the danger of unfair prejudice, confusion of the issues, or if the evidence would be misleading, or based on considerations of undue delay, waste of time, or needless presentation of cumulative evidence.

Mr. Fanning cannot possibly be required to comment on and provide specific objections to each and every one of the approximately 786 individual exhibits proposed and listed by Complaint Counsel, although Mr. Fanning previously identified in his pending motions certain proposed exhibits that must be barred as inadmissible in whole or in part. Many of the other

proposed exhibits identified by Complaint Counsel likewise must be excluded in accordance

with the mandates of 16 CFR §3.43(b), Fed. R. Ev. 602, and Fed. R. Civ. P. 701. Counsel for

Mr. Fanning has indicated a willingness to confer with Complaint Counsel in an effort to narrow

disputes concerning other specific proposed exhibits in hopes of streamlining the trial, provided

that Complaint Counsel is willing to cooperate. Meanwhile, Mr. Fanning presses his blanket

objections to the proposed exhibit list, and reserves all objections.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Respondent John Fanning requests this Court to strike and/or

bar at trial all proposed exhibits that fail the basic standards of admissibility.
