JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTIONS

Complaint Counsel and Respondent LabMD, Inc. respectfully request that the Court extend the deadline for responses to any motion filed between December 23, 2013 and December 26, 2013 before the Administrative Law Judge in this matter to be January 7, 2014. The parties further respectfully request that the deadline for filing any permitted reply to any such response be set as January 14, 2014.

Both Complaint Counsel and Respondent anticipate filing motions related to discovery prior to the winter holidays. Good cause exists for the extension sought in this Motion because Complaint Counsel and Respondent's counsel have personal commitments during the winter holidays that would make it difficult to respond fully to the issues raised in the anticipated motions. This extension of time to respond to such motions will not impact any other deadlines related to this case. The parties respectfully submit that an extension of time for each party to respond to motions filed during this period is warranted to ensure that all relevant issues are fully addressed.

Rule 3.22(f) allows the Administrative Law Judge to waive the deadlines otherwise imposed by Rule 3.22 for motions for extensions of time filed by the parties. Thus, with the

Court's permission, the parties request until January 7, 2014 to respond to any motions filed between December 23, 2013 and December 26, 2013, and request that the deadline for filing any permitted reply to any such response be set as January 14, 2014.

Accordingly, the parties request that their joint Motion be granted.


