This letter responds to BP-Amoco's request for prior approval for the "Intellectual Property License Agreement" and "Intellectual Property Assignment and Patent License Grantback Agreement" submitted to the Commission on April 13, 2000, and the "Transition Services Agreement" submitted to the Commission on April 18, 2000, pursuant to Paragraph II.C of the proposed Decision and Order. Paragraph II.C requires Respondents to enter into and receive prior Commission approval for certain license agreements and a transition services agreement prior to the divestiture of the ARCO Alaska Assets to Phillips Petroleum Company.
