### PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Plaintiffs, the Federal Trade Commission ("Commission" or "FTC") and the People of the State of New York ("New York"), having filed their Complaint for a permanent injunction and other relief in this matter, pursuant to Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. §§ 53(b), and pursuant to New York's Executive Law (NY Executive Law) § 63(12) and General Business Law (NY GBL) Article 22-A, and the Court having considered the pleadings, declarations, exhibits, memoranda of law and argument of counsel of the parties, and made findings of fact and conclusions of law in its Memorandum Opinion dated January 24, 2001, and finding further that:

1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this case and there is good cause to believe it will have jurisdiction of all parties hereto, pursuant to 15 U.S.C. §§ 45(a) and 53(b), and 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331, 1337(a) and 1345, and this Court has supplemental jurisdiction over the New York state law claims pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1367. The Complaint states a claim upon

which relief may be granted under Sections 5 and 13(b) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 45, 53(b) and under NY Executive Law § 63(12) and NY GBL Article 22-A.

- 2. There is good cause to believe that Defendants have engaged and are likely to engage in acts or practices constituting violations of Section 5 of the FTC Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a) and NY Executive Law § 63(12) and NY GBL Article 22-A, and that the Plaintiffs have therefore demonstrated a likelihood of prevailing on the merits of this action;
- 3. There is a substantial likelihood that, absent the relief set forth herein, Defendants will conceal, dissipate, or otherwise divert their assets, thereby defeating the possibility of effective final relief in the form of equitable monetary relief for consumers;
- 4. Weighing the equities and considering the Plaintiffs' probable success on the merits, issuance of the relief set forth herein is in the public interest; and
- 5. No security is required of any agency of the United States for the issuance of a preliminary injunction. Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c).

### **Definitions**

For the purpose of this preliminary injunction order, the following definitions shall apply:

- C. "Individual Defendants" means Bruce A. Chew, David Bernstein, and their successors, assigns, agents, servants, employees, whether acting directly or through any entity, corporation, subsidiary, division, or other device, unless specified otherwise.
- D. "In or affecting commerce" shall mean as defined in Section 4 of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 44.
- E. "Document" is equal in scope and synonymous in meaning to the usage of the term in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 34(a), and includes writings, drawings, charts, graphs, photographs, audio and video recordings, computer records, and any other data compilations from which information can be obtained.

- F. "Assets" means all real and personal property of any Defendant, or held for the benefit of any Defendant, including, but not limited to, "goods," "instruments," "equipment," "fixtures," "general intangibles," "inventory," "checks," or "notes" (as these terms are defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), and all cash, wherever located.
- G. "World Wide Web" means a system used on the Internet for cross-referencing and retrieving information. A "Web site" is a set of electronic documents, usually a home page and subordinate pages, readily viewable on computer by anyone with access to the Web, standard software, and knowledge of the Web site's location or address.
- H. "Internet" refers to the global information system that is logically linked together by a globally unique address space based on the Internet Protocol (IP) or its subsequent extensions/follow-ons; is able to support communications using the Transmission Control Protocol/Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) suite or its subsequent extensions/follow-ons, and/or other IP-compatible protocols; and provides, uses or makes accessible, either publicly or privately, high level services layered on the communications and related infrastructure described herein, including, but not limited to, the following forms of electronic communication: electronic mail and email mailing lists, the World Wide Web, USENET newsgroups, Internet Relay Chat, instant messaging, wireless data messaging, FTP/file transfer protocol, and remote computer access from anywhere in the world thereto.
  - I. "Clearly and conspicuously" means as follows:
    - In an advertisement communicated through an electronic medium (such as television, video, radio, and interactive media such as the Internet, any Web site, or online services), if the disclosure is given

orally, the disclosure shall be delivered in a volume and cadence sufficient for an ordinary consumer to hear and comprehend. For a disclosure given in the video portion of an advertisement, the disclosure shall be of a size and shade, and shall appear on the screen for a duration, sufficient for an ordinary consumer to read, or obtain access to, and comprehend.

- Disclosures in interactive media are required to provide consumers material information about a transaction. Whether a disclosure meets this standard is measured by its performance—that is, how a reasonable consumer actually perceives and understands the disclosure within the context of the entire ad. The key is the overall net impression of the disclosure—that is, whether the claims consumers take from the disclosure are truthful and substantiated.
- The disclosure must assume that consumers do not read an entire
   Web site, just as they do not read every word on a printed page.
- 3. In addition to the foregoing, in interactive media such as the Internet, any Web site, or online services, the disclosure shall be unavoidable and shall be presented prior to the consumer incurring any financial obligation.

The disclosure shall be in understandable language and syntax. Nothing contrary to, inconsistent with, or that otherwise interferes with a consumer's understanding of the disclosure shall be used in any advertisement. Further, a subsequent disclosure only limits or qualifies a prior disclosure and

#### **Conduct Prohibitions**

I.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that in connection with the advertising, promotion, offering or sale of goods or services in commerce, on or through the Internet, the World Wide Web, any Web site, or otherwise, Defendants are hereby preliminarily restrained and enjoined from:

- A. Making or assisting others in making, directly or by implication, orally or in writing, any misrepresentation of material fact, including, but not limited to:
  - 1. That Defendants will not bill consumers who visit Defendants' Web sites; or
  - 2. That Defendants will use consumers' credit card account information for age verification purposes only.
- B. Misrepresenting that accessing or viewing any of Defendants Web services does not entail a cost.
- C. Misrepresenting any material fact about the terms of membership of any program or about any charges to be made for any goods or services.
- D Misrepresenting any fact material to a consumer's decision to purchase Defendants' products or services.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that in connection with the advertising, promotion, offering or sale of goods or services in commerce, on or through the Internet, the World Wide Web, any Web site, or otherwise, Defendants are hereby preliminarily restrained and enjoined from failing to disclose clearly and conspicuously, directly or by implication, orally or in writing, any material fact, including, but not limited to:

- A. the conditions under which a free tour or preview of Defendants' Web sites ends:
- B. the conditions under which Defendants will enroll consumers as paying members to Defendants' Web sites, including whether the consumers will be subject to recurring billing;
- C. the conditions under which Defendants will treat consumers as having authorized Defendants to bill consumers' credit or debit card accounts;
- D. the conditions under which Defendants will bill consumers' credit or debit card accounts; and
- E. the conditions under which, and mechanisms by which, consumers may cancel memberships.

#### III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in connection with the advertising, promotion, offering for sale, or selling of adult entertainment products or services in commerce, on or through the Internet, Defendants are hereby preliminarily restrained and enjoined from failing to disclose

clearly and conspicuously, directly or by implication, orally or in writing, any material fact relating to a consumer's decision to purchase Defendants' adult entertainment products or services, including but not limited to:

- A. The conditions under which Defendants will bill consumer's credit or debit card accounts, including whether the consumer will be subject to recurring billing.
- B. The complete terms and conditions of Defendants' offer, including the procedures for cancellation and when cancellation will be effective.

### Asset Freeze

#### IV.

active concert or participation with them, are hereby restrained and enjoined, absent approval of the Plaintiffs or of the Court, from distributing or lending, directly or indirectly, any money to defendants' officers, directors and shareholders or entities in which those persons have interests. As used herein, money includes any funds, property, accounts, contracts, shares of stock, lists of consumer names, or other assets, wherever located, including outside the United States, that are (1) owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by any Defendant, in whole or in part; (2) in the actual or constructive possession of any Defendant; or (3) owned, controlled by, or in the actual or constructive possession of any corporation, partnership, or other entity directly or indirectly owned, managed, or controlled by, or under common control with any Defendant, including, but not limited to, any assets held by, for, or under the name of any Defendant at any bank, savings and loan institution, or correspondent bank, or with any broker-dealer, escrow agent, title company,

commodity trading company, precious metal dealer, international business corporation ("IBC"), trust or other financial institution or depository of any kind;

Provided, however, that Corporate Defendants may continue to pay salaries, including those paid to Individual Defendants, at the rate being paid on January 24, 2001, and

Provided, further, that Defendants may transfer overseas funds for the sole purpose of repatriating them to the United States and depositing them into a designated domestic account, as set forth in Paragraph IX of this Order.

# Reporting By Banks And Other Third Parties

V.

agent, title company, commodity trading company, precious metal dealer, international business corporation ("IBC"), trust, business entity, or person that holds, controls or maintains accounts or assets of any Defendant, or has held, controlled or maintained any account or asset of any Defendant at any time since January 1, 1996, upon service with a copy of this Order, shall:

- A. Provide counsel for the plaintiffs, within five (5) business days of entry of this Order, a statement setting forth:
  - the identification of each account or asset titled in the name, individually or
    jointly, of any Defendant, or held on behalf of, or for the benefit of, any
    Defendant;

- the balance of each such account, or a description and appraisal of the value of such asset, as of the close of business on January 24, 2001;
- 3. the identification of any safe deposit box that either is titled in the name, individually or jointly, of any Defendant, or is otherwise subject to access by any Defendant;
- 4. if an account, safe deposit box, or other asset has been closed or removed, the date closed or removed, the balance on such date, and the manner in which such account or asset was closed or removed; and
- B. The Plaintiff's are granted leave to subpoen a documents immediately from any such financial institution, account custodian, or other aforementioned entity concerning the nature, location, status, and extent of Defendants' assets, and compliance with this Order, by serving a copy of this Order.

## **Financial Statements**

### VI.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each Defendant, within forty-eight (48) hours of entry of this Order, prepare and deliver to counsel for Plaintiffs completed financial statements on the forms attached to this Order as Attachments A and B, for themselves and for any business entity under which they conduct business, or of which they are an officer. The financial statements shall be accurate as of the date of entry of this Order, and shall account for any difference between any balance stated therein and the balance as of January 24, 2001.

# Accounting of Corporate Revenue and Expenditures

## VII.

## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- A. The Corporate Defendants shall make and keep accurate records reflecting any and all funds or assets received from any source after January 24, 2001, and any and all expenditures after the effective date of this Order totaling \$500 or more, including without limitation expenditures for salaries as permitted by Paragraph IV.
- B. Beginning 30 days after the date this Order is signed, and continuing on a quarterly basis thereafter, no later than the first day of the first month of each quarter, the Corporate Defendants shall provide the plaintiffs with a true and accurate statement reflecting:
  - All funds or assets received from any source after January 24, 2001, including without limitation funds received by payment, loan or gift;
  - 2. The name, address, and telephone number of the source of all funds or assets received from any source after the effective date of this Order, including without limitation funds received by payment, loan, or gift;
  - 3. The amount of each expenditure totaling \$500 or more; and
  - 4. The name, address, and telephone number of each recipient of any expenditure totaling \$500 or more.
- C. The reports described in this section shall be supplied to the addresses listed in Paragraph XIII.

#### VIII.

# IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

- A. Each Defendant is enjoined from engaging, whether directly, in concert with others, or through any business, entity, corporation, subsidiary, division or other device, in the advertising, marketing; or sale of any product or service in commerce, on or through the Internet, the World Wide Web, or any Web site, that involves charging, debiting or billing consumers unless Defendants first obtain, pursuant to Local Civil Rule 65.1.1, a bond in the amount of \$10 million to satisfy any judgment entered against Defendants, file such bond with the Clerk and obtain the Clerk's approval for such bond.
- B. The terms and conditions of the bond requirement in Subparagraph A, above, shall be as follows:
  - The bond is conditioned upon compliance by each such Defendant with this
    preliminary injunction and upon satisfaction of any money judgment entered
    herein;
  - The bond shall remain in full force and effect pending the final determination of this action or until further order of the Court;
  - 3. The bond shall be an insurance agreement that cites this Order as the subject matter of the bond, and shall provide surety for financial loss that is issued by a surety as defined by Local Civil Rule 65.1.1;
  - 4. The bond shall be in favor of the Federal Trade Commission and the Attorney

    General for the State of New York for the benefit of any consumer injured as

- a result of any deceptive misrepresentation or violation of this Order;
- 5. Each such Defendant shall provide written notice and proof of the bond to the Federal Trade Commission and the Attorney General for the State of New York at least ten (10) days before the commencement of the activity for which the bond is required;
- 6. The bond required by this Order shall be in addition to, and not in lieu of, any bond required by federal, state, or local law, or the order of another court;
- 7. Defendants shall not disclose the existence of any bond to any consumer or other purchaser or prospective purchaser of goods or services in commerce without simultaneously making the following disclosure: THIS BOND IS REQUIRED BY PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ORDER OF THE U.S. DISTRICT COURT THAT THERE IS GOOD CAUSE TO BELIEVE THE DEFENDANTS HAVE ENGAGED IN ACTS CONSTITUTING VIOLATIONS OF SECTION 5 OF THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION ACT AND VIOLATIONS OF NEW YORK EXECUTIVE LAW § 63(12) and NEW YORK GENERAL BUSINESS LAW Article 22-A.

## Repatriation of Assets

#### IX.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall have a duty to immediately:

A. Provide the plaintiffs with a full accounting of all funds, documents and assets either held outside of the territory of the United States or in banks or other financial

institutions not organized under U.S. law which are held either: (1) by them; (2) for their benefit; or (3) under their direct or indirect control, jointly or singly;

- B. Transfer to the territory of the United States all funds, documents and assets in foreign countries held either: (1) by them; (2) for their benefit; or (3) under their direct or indirect control, jointly or singly. In the case of any liquid funds or assets held in foreign countries, each Defendant shall transfer such funds or assets to domestic accounts in the New York state branch of a bank organized under U.S. law titled in that Defendant's name and designated prior to any transfer by written notice to counsel for Plaintiffs, such written notice to state the amount of the transfer and identify the domestic account by financial institution, title holder, and account number. *Provided, however*, that Defendants may maintain foreign accounts with limited funds if and to the extent that this is demonstrated to be necessary to the efficient operation of the business;
- C. Hold and retain all such repatriated funds, documents and assets and prevent any transfer, disposition, or dissipation whatsoever of any such assets or funds, except as permitted in Paragraph IV; and
- D. Provide plaintiffs with access to Defendants' records and documents held by financial institutions outside the territorial United States, by signing the Consent to Release of Financial Records attached hereto as Attachment C.

## Record Keeping

#### X.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants, or any persons served with a copy of this Order, are hereby restrained and enjoined from:

- A. Failing to create and maintain books, records, accounts, and data which, in reasonable detail, accurately, fairly, and completely reflect their incomes, disbursements, transactions, and use of monies, in any way relevant to this action;
- B. Destroying, erasing, mutilating, concealing, altering, transferring, or otherwise disposing of, in any manner, directly or indirectly, any contracts, accounting data, correspondence, advertisements, computer tapes, discs, or other computerized records, books, written or printed records, handwritten notes, telephone logs, telephone scripts receipt books, ledgers, personal and business canceled checks and check registers, bank statements, appointment books, copies of federal, state or local business or personal income or property tax returns, and other documents or records of any kind that are in any way relevant to this action, from January 1, 1996 to the present; and
- C. Failing to notify counsel for the Plaintiffs of the receipt of any funds by any Defendant subsequent to the date of entry of this order, identifying each such receipt by the name, address, and telephone number of the payer.

## **Credit Reports**

## XI.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Section 604(1) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1681b(1), any consumer reporting agency may furnish a consumer report concerning any of the Defendants to the Plaintiffs.

## Service of this Order

#### XII.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Order may be served by any means, including facsimile transmission, upon any financial institution or other entity or person that may have possession, custody, or control of any documents or assets of the Defendants, or that may be subject to any provision of this Order. Service upon any branch or office of any financial institution shall effect service upon the entire financial institution.

## FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION

- (3) "In any (... statement under penalty of peniury as permitted under section 1746 of title 28, United States Code) in any proceeding before or ancillary to any court or grand jury of the United States knowingly makes any false material declaration or makes or uses any other information ... knowing the same to contain any false material declaration." (18 U.S.C. § 1623)

For a felony conviction under the provisions cited above, federal law provides that the fine may be not more than the greater of (i) \$250,000 for an individual or \$500,000 for a corporation, or (ii) if the felony results in pecuniary gain to any person or pecuniary loss to any person other than the defendant, the greater of twice the gross gain or twice the gross loss. 18 U.S.C. § 3571.

- (3) "in any (... statement under penalty of perjury as permitted under section 1746 of title 28, United States Code) in any proceeding before or sacillary to any court or grand jury of the United States knowingly makes any false material declaration or makes or uses any other information ... knowing the same to contain any false material declaration" (18 U.S.C. § 1623).

For a felony conviction under the provisions cited above, federal law provides that the fine may be not more than the greater of (i) \$250,000 for an individual or \$500,000 for a corporation, or (ii) if the felony results in pecuniary gain to any person other than the defondant, the greater of twice the gross gain or twice the gross loss. 18 U.S.C. § 3571.
