**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
FILE APPLICATION FOR IN CAMERA TREATMENT**

Non-Party Louis A. Weiss Memorial Hospital (“Weiss”), by counsel, hereby moves for a brief extension of time for Weiss to file its Application for In Camera Treatment of documents produced pursuant to the subpoena duces tecum of Evanston Northwestern Healthcare Corporation’s and ENH Medical Group, Inc.’s (collectively “Respondents”) issued on April 19, 2004. In support thereof, Weiss states as follows:

1. By a letter dated December 14, 2004, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) gave notice to Weiss that it intended to place certain documents on its exhibit list and to offer those documents into evidence at the administrative trial in this matter.
2. The notice by the FTC provided that the documents were Trial Exhibit Number CX00882 with the beginning document number as VHS-000069 and ending number VHS-000111. Weiss was not provided with a copy of the precise documents which the FTC intended to offer.
3. On January 4, 2005 one of the counsel for Weiss spoke with a counsel for the FTC concerning the documents in question and the documents were identified with specificity.

4. After a cursory review of the documents in question, it is clear that at least two of the three agreements contain confidentiality clauses.

5. Weiss must now assess whether it intends to file an Application for In Camera Treatment of these documents pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 3.45(b).


6. This extension of time is not sought for delay, but only to provide Weiss a reasonable amount of time to evaluate and determine the nature of the documents in question; to provide Weiss a reasonable amount of time to ascertain any applicable privileges; and to allow Weiss to determine the implications of the pre-existing confidentiality clauses.

WHEREFORE, Non-Party Louis A. Weiss Memorial Hospital respectfully prays that it be granted up to and including January 14, 2005 to file its Application for In Camera Treatment.
