Counsel for Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission ("Plaintiff" or "FTC") and counsel for Defendants Del Sol LLC, also d/b/a Del Sol Educational and Fernando Lopez Gonzalez (collectively, "Defendants") hereby state as follows:

- 1. On April 25, 2005, the Honorable Judge Gary Allen Feess entered a "Temporary Restraining Order with an Asset Freeze, an Accounting, Limited Expedited Discovery, Immediate Access and Other Equitable Relief, and Order for Defendants to Show Cause Why a Preliminary Injunction Should Not Issue" ("TRO").
- 2. The TRO was personally served on each of the Defendants on April 27, 2005.
- 3. Under the terms of the TRO, the Defendants are to serve and file their Opposition to the issuance of a preliminary injunction no later than May 2, 2005. Plaintiff is to serve and file its Response, including any supplementary evidence and no later than May 4, 2005.
- 4. A hearing on the issuance of a preliminary injunction is presently set for May 5, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. and the TRO shall expire on May 5, 2005 at 11:59 p.m.
- 5. Defendants have now requested additional time in which to prepare a Response to the Order to show cause as to why a preliminary injunction should not be issued, to comply with certain deadlines set forth in the TRO, and to continue the depositions of defendant Fernando Lopez Gonzalez and Fernando Tapia Gonzalez.

Through their counsel, all parties have agreed to stipulate to continue the preliminary injunction hearing, modify the briefing schedule for the preliminary injunction hearing, extend

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certain deadlines set forth in the TRO, and continue the depositions of defendant Fernando Lopez Gonzalez and Fernando Tapia Gonzalez.

Plaintiff and the Defendants, by and through their counsel, hereby stipulate as follows:

- 1. The parties agree that the hearing on the issuance of a preliminary injunction shall take place on May 19, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. or at the Court's first available subsequent date.
- 2. Defendants shall serve and file any Opposition no later than May 13, 2005 4:00 p.m.
- 3. Plaintiff shall serve and file any Response including any supplemental evidence no later than May 17, 2005 4:00 p.m.
- 4. Service of Defendant's Opposition and Plaintiff's Response shall be made by personal or overnight delivery, facsimile, or e-mail (Adobe Acrobat .pdf files only).
- 5. Defendants shall provide to counsel for the FTC the financial statements, verified statements, and accountings required pursuant to Section IV (Financial Statements and Accounting) and Section V (Repatriation of Foreign Assets) of the TRO by May 6, 2005 4:00 p.m.
- 6. The deposition of Defendant Fernando Lopez Gonzalez is continued to May 10, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. The deposition of Fernando Tapia Gonzalez is continued to May 10, 2005 at 1:00 p.m.
- 7. The TRO shall otherwise continue in full force and effect, including but not limited to the injunctive provisions, the asset freeze, and the access to books and records, until such ///

time that the judge issues a ruling on the issuance of a preliminary injunction against the Defendants.
