


Several months ago, two of Respondents' counsel, including Respondents' lead counsel, committed to participate in out-of-town, professional meetings on October 26-29, 2009. Under the current schedule, Respondents' counsel would effectively lose four of the seven business days provided by Rule 3.52 to reply to Complaint Counsel's Answering Brief. Respondents' counsel inquired if Complaint Counsel would object to a request that Respondents be permitted until November 4, 2009, a date which would provide Respondents four additional business days, to file their Reply Brief, and Complaint Counsel stated that they would not object.


