

ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENA

On October 30, 2009, Complaint Counsel, pursuant to Rule 3.34(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, submitted an application for the issuance of one subpoena commanding Douglas Gillespie of Exide Technologies to attend and give testimony at an adjudicative hearing. Respondent has not submitted an opposition to Complaint Counsel's request.

According to Complaint Counsel's brief description of the intended testimony of Gillespie, the testimony sought appears to be reasonably relevant to Respondent's proffer as set forth in the October 15, 2009 Order reopening the record and setting hearing schedule. Complaint Counsel has represented that Gillespie is located in the United States.

This Order does not constitute a ruling on admissibility. Pursuant to Rule 3.43 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, "[e]vidence, even if relevant, may be excluded . . . by considerations of undue delay, waste of time, or needless presentation of cumulative evidence." 16 C.F.R. § 3.43(b).

The application is GRANTED.
