

**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY  
HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On March 18, 2010, non-party Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP") submitted an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time ("Motion"), seeking an extension of the time for HP to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Complaint Counsel on March 8, 2010 ("Subpoena").

HP states that Complaint Counsel has agreed to an extension of time through March 29, 2010 so that the parties can attempt to reach an agreement on the scope of the Subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that HP shall have until March 29, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena served upon HP by Complaint Counsel on March 8, 2010.
