
Complaint Counsel served HP with the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on Monday, March 8, 2010. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a Motion to Limit or Quash Complaint Counsel’s Subpoena *Duces Tecum* was March 18, 2010. On March 18, 2010, HP filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time in regards to the Federal Trade Commission Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, which was granted on March 19, 2010. The time in which HP may file a Motion to Limit or Quash Complaint Counsel’s Subpoena *Duces Tecum* was extended through Monday, March 29, 2010.

Complaint Counsel has agreed to a second extension of time for HP to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* through April 8, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the scope of the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*.

Accordingly, HP respectfully requests that this Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time be granted and that HP be given until April 8, 2010 to file a Motion to Quash or Limit Complaint Counsel's Subpoena *Duces Tecum*.
