
**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTIONS OF NON-PARTY
HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENAS *DUCES TECUM***

On March 26, 2010, non-party Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) submitted two unopposed motions for extension of time: (1) a Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time for HP to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Complaint Counsel on March 8, 2010;¹ and (2) an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time for HP to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Respondent Intel on March 19, 2010 (collectively, “HP’s Unopposed Motions for Extension of Time”).

HP states that Complaint Counsel has agreed to a second extension of time for HP to move to limit or quash Complaint Counsel’s subpoena through April 8, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the scope of the subpoena. Regarding the subpoena from Intel, HP states that Intel does not oppose an extension of time for HP to file a motion to limit or quash Intel’s subpoena until April 12, 2010, so that the parties can try to reach agreement on the scope of that subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, HP’s Unopposed Motions for Extension of Time are each GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that: HP shall have until April 8, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served upon HP by Complaint Counsel on March 8, 2010; and, HP shall have until April 12, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served upon HP by Intel on March 19, 2010.
