

**MICROSOFT CORPORATION'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE MOTION TO QUASH OR LIMIT INTEL CORPORATION'S  
SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

Non-party Microsoft Corporation ("Microsoft") files this unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Motion to Quash or Limit Intel Corporation's ("Intel") Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, received by Microsoft's agent for service of process on March 22, 2010 ("Subpoena"). The Subpoena includes thirty-three (33) requests for production of documents.


Pursuant to the FTC's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c), Microsoft has ten (10) days in which to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena, or until April 1, 2010.

Microsoft's Counsel and Intel's Counsel are in negotiations to resolve Microsoft's concerns arising from the scope and burden created by the Subpoena. Due to the scope of the Subpoena, more time is needed for Microsoft and Intel to complete their negotiations effectively. As a result, Microsoft's Counsel and Intel's Counsel have agreed that Microsoft shall have an additional thirty (30) days in which to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena.

Accordingly, Microsoft respectfully requests that this motion be granted and that Microsoft be given until May 3, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena.<sup>1</sup> Further, during such time, Microsoft's obligations to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled.

Undersigned counsel represents that they have conferred with Intel's Counsel and that Intel's Counsel does not object to the proposed extension.
