

**ONE LAPTOP PER CHILD FOUNDATION AND ONE LAPTOP PER CHILD  
ASSOCIATION'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A  
MOTION TO QUASH OR LIMIT INTEL CORPORATION'S  
SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

Non-parties One Laptop Per Child Foundation ("OLPC Foundation") and One Laptop Per Child Association ("OLPC Association") (collectively, "OLPC") file this unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File a Motion to Quash or Limit Intel Corporation's ("Intel") Subpoena *Duces Tecum* ("Subpoena"), received by OLPC Foundation on March 29, 2010 and OLPC Association on April 5, 2010.


The Subpoena includes fifteen (15) requests for production of documents. OLPC and Intel are in negotiations in an effort to resolve OLPC's concerns regarding the scope and burdensomeness of the Subpoena. Due to the complexity of the issues, more time is needed in order for OLPC and Intel to conclude their negotiations. As a result, OLPC and Intel have agreed to an extension of time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena to April 23, 2010.

Accordingly, OLPC respectfully requests that this motion be granted and that OLPC be given until April 23, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena, without

prejudice to seek a further extension of this deadline. Further, during such time, OLPC's obligations to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled.

Undersigned counsel represents that they have conferred with Intel's Counsel and that Intel's Counsel does not object to the proposed extension.


