

**MOTION OF JASON C. KRAVITZ AND GINA M. MCCREADIE
TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL**

Undersigned counsel Jason C. Kravitz and Gina M. McCreddie, and the law firm Nixon Peabody LLP, hereby move to withdraw as counsel to respondents Dyna-E International, Inc. and George Wheeler (“Respondents”). As reasons for their motion to withdraw, counsel state as follows:

1. On or about July 31, 2009, Respondents and counsel for the Federal Trade Commission (the “Commission”) executed an agreement containing consent order (the “Proposed Consent Order”).
2. Thereafter, the Secretary of the Commission withdrew this matter from adjudication in accordance with § 3.25(c) of its Rules, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(c).
3. The Commission thereafter accepted the Proposed Consent Order and placed the agreement on the public record for a period of thirty (30) days.
4. The Commission thereafter duly considered the comment filed by an interested person.
5. By Decision and Order dated December 15, 2009, the Commission approved the Proposed Consent Order.

6. As this matter is now resolved, undersigned counsel respectfully request to withdraw from this matter.

WHEREFORE, undersigned counsel respectfully request:

- (i) that Jason C. Kravitz, Gina M. McCreadie, and the law firm Nixon Peabody LPP be permitted to withdraw as counsel to respondents Dyna-E International, Inc. and George Wheeler; and
- (ii) such other relief as is just and appropriate.
