**ONE LAPTOP PER CHILD FOUNDATION AND ONE LAPTOP PER CHILD  
ASSOCIATION'S SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
FILE A MOTION TO QUASH OR LIMIT INTEL CORPORATION'S  
SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

Non-parties One Laptop Per Child Foundation ("OLPC Foundation") and One Laptop Per Child Association ("OLPC Association") (collectively, "OLPC") file this second unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File a Motion to Quash or Limit Intel Corporation's ("Intel") Subpoena *Duces Tecum* ("Subpoena").

OLPC Foundation received Intel's Subpoena on March 29, 2010 and OLPC Association received the Subpoena on April 5, 2010. On April 8, 2010, OLPC filed its first Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File a Motion to Quash or Limit Intel Corporation's Subpoena *Duces Tecum*. The motion was granted on April 8, 2010.


Intel and OLPC are still negotiating the scope of the Subpoena. As a result, OLPC and Intel have agreed to an extension of time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena to May 5, 2010.

Accordingly, OLPC respectfully requests that this motion be granted and that OLPC be given until May 5, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena, without

prejudice to seek a further extension of this deadline. Further, during such time, OLPC's obligations to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled.

Undersigned counsel represents that they have conferred with Intel's Counsel and that Intel's Counsel does not object to the proposed extension.


