**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY
GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. INC. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On April 22, 2010, non-party Globalfoundries U.S. Inc. (“Globalfoundries”) submitted an unopposed motion for extension of time to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Respondent Intel on April 15, 2010 (“Subpoena”). Globalfoundries states that Respondent has agreed to an extension of time through May 17, 2010, so Globalfoundries and Respondent can continue their negotiations to resolve Globalfoundries’ concerns regarding the scope of the Subpoena. Globalfoundries also requests that its obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena be tolled during the period of the extension.

Based on the foregoing, Globalfoundries’ Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Globalfoundries shall have until May 17, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served upon Globalfoundries by Respondent on April 15, 2010, and further, that Globalfoundries’ obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled during the period of the extension.
