
**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY
HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On April 29, 2010, non-party Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP") submitted its Fifth Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time for HP to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Complaint Counsel on March 8, 2010.¹

HP states that Complaint Counsel has agreed to a fifth extension of time for HP to move to limit or quash Complaint Counsel's subpoena, until May 10, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the scope of the subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, HP's Fifth Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that HP shall have until May 10, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served upon HP by Complaint Counsel on March 8, 2010.
