


**ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTIES
HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY AND DAVID DONATELLI FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH
SUBPOENA AD TESTIFICANDUM**

On June 9, 2010, non-parties Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) and David Donatelli (“Donatelli”) (collectively, the “Non-parties”) submitted a Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time, seeking a further extension of the time permitted to move to limit or quash a subpoena *ad testificandum* served upon Donatelli by Respondent Intel Corporation on May 28, 2010. The Non-parties previously received an extension of time through June 9, 2010. *See* Order Granting Unopposed Motion of Non-Parties Hewlett-Packard Company and David Donatelli for Extension of Time, June 4, 2010.

The Non-parties state that Respondent does not oppose an extension of time through June 11, 2010, so that the parties may continue to try to reach agreement regarding the subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, the Non-parties’ second unopposed motion for extension of time is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that the Non-parties shall have until June 11, 2010 to file a motion to limit or quash the subpoena *ad testificandum* to Donatelli served by Respondent on May 28, 2010.
