Thank you for the comment you submitted on August 27, 2010, regarding the above-referenced matter. Your comment was placed on the public record pursuant to Section 2.34 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 2.34.

Your comment indicates your belief that the FTC's decision to pursue law enforcement action against Reverb Communications, Inc. is unwarranted. While the Commission is not at liberty to disclose the specific reasons underlying this law enforcement action or its analysis of the case, the Commission believes that its decision to take action in this matter was necessary and important to prevent deceptive marketing to consumers.
