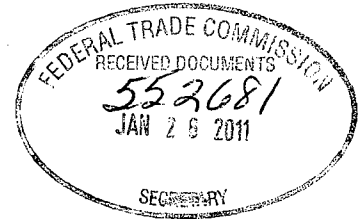


**ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S UNOPPOSED MOTION
TO PLACE COMPLAINT ON THE PUBLIC RECORD**

On January 24, 2011, Complaint Counsel submitted an Unopposed Motion to Place Complaint on the Public Record. Complaint Counsel states that, after consultation with Respondent's counsel, Complaint Counsel initially placed a redacted version of the Complaint in the public record of this matter, in order to protect from disclosure quotes from Respondent's documents and prior testimony that had been protected from disclosure during the pre-complaint investigation.

Complaint Counsel argues that making the Complaint public will also serve the policy of open access to the Commission's adjudicative proceedings. Complaint Counsel notes that a virtually identical version of the Complaint has already been unsealed in a related Federal District Court proceeding between the parties and that the redacted material in the Complaint does not reveal trade secrets, customer-specific information, or other specific material that could be considered sensitive. In addition, Complaint Counsel states that Respondent does not oppose placing an unredacted version of the Complaint on the public record at this time.

Based on the foregoing, Complaint Counsel's Unopposed Motion to Place Complaint on the Public Record is hereby GRANTED.
