Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time

Star Pipe Products, Ltd. ("Star") files this motion to extend the time permitted for Star to move to limit or quash the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* and Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* Deposition served on Star by McWane, Inc. ("McWane") on February 27, 2012 and the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on Star by Complaint Counsel on February 28, 2012. Specifically, Star requests that it have until March 23, 2012 to move to limit or quash the subpoenas. Star, McWane, and Complaint Counsel are in the process of conferring about the subpoenas, and previously agreed to extend Star's deadline to March 16, 2012, which extension was granted by order of the Chief Administrative Law Judge signed March 8, 2012. Star, McWane, and Complaint Counsel have continued to negotiate to try to reach an agreement on the subpoenas, and McWane and Complaint Counsel do not oppose the further extension of time requested herein for Star to file any motions to limit or quash while the parties continue their negotiations in good faith.

Accordingly, Star respectfully requests that this Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time be granted and that Star be given until March 23, 2012 to move to limit or quash the subpoenas issued by McWane and Complaint Counsel.

**ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION OF
STAR PIPE PRODUCTS, LTD. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On March 16, 2012, Star Pipe Products, Ltd. ("Star") filed an unopposed motion to extend the time for Star to move to limit or quash (1) the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* and Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* Deposition served on it on February 27, 2012 by Respondent McWane, Inc. ("McWane"), and (2) the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it on February 28, 2012 by Complaint Counsel (collectively, the Subpoenas). Star previously received an extension of time through March 16, 2012. *See* Order Granting Unopposed Motion of Star Pipe Products, Ltd. for Extension of Time, March 8, 2012.

In support of its motion, Star states that it is in the process of conferring with McWane and Complaint Counsel about the Subpoenas, and that McWane and Complaint Counsel do not oppose a further extension of time for Star to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoenas through March 23, 2012, while the parties negotiate in good faith the scope of the Subpoenas.

Accordingly, based on the foregoing, the Second Unopposed Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for Star to file any motion to limit or quash the Subpoenas shall be March 23, 2012
