**ORDER GRANTING NON-PARTY CATERPILLAR INC.' S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On March 23, 2012, non-party Caterpillar Inc. ("Caterpillar") filed a motion for an extension of time to file a motion for *in camera* treatment. Under the Scheduling Order in this case, the deadline for submitting motions for *in camera* treatment under Rule 3.45(b) is March 20, 2012. Caterpillar seeks an order extending the deadline to March 29, 2012.

In support of its request, Caterpillar asserts that on March 19, 2012, it received, via regular U.S. mail, a letter dated March 13, 2012 from Respondent OSF Healthcare System stating that it intended to offer into evidence at trial confidential materials produced by Caterpillar. Caterpillar also states that it was not aware of the deadline in this matter until March 21, 2012 when it was provided with a copy of the scheduling order. Caterpillar is requesting an extension until March 29, 2012 to file a motion for *in camera* treatment.

Based on the foregoing, there is good cause to grant Caterpillar the extension requested. 16 C.F.R. § 3.21(c). Moreover, extension of this deadline will not affect other pending deadlines in the case, the commencement of the evidentiary hearing, or the issuance of an initial decision in the case. Accordingly, the Motion is GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for non-party Caterpillar to file a motion for *in camera* treatment shall be March 29, 2012.
