**SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Non-party Sigma Corporation (“Sigma”) files this motion to extend the time permitted for Sigma to move to limit or quash (1) the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* that McWane, Inc. (“McWane”) served on Sigma on February 16, 2012, and (2) the Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* that McWane served on Sigma on February 17, 2012 (collectively, the “Subpoenas”). Specifically, Sigma requests that it have until April 6, 2012 to move to limit or quash the Subpoenas. Sigma and McWane are in the process of conferring about the Subpoenas, and McWane does not oppose the extension of time for Sigma to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoenas through April 6, 2012, while the parties negotiate in good faith to limit the Subpoenas issued to Sigma and its employees.

On February 29, 2012, Sigma filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time requesting an extension until March 30, 2012. On March 1, 2012, Judge Chappell granted Sigma’s motion. In both the February 29, 2012 and instant Unopposed Motions for Extension of Time,

Sigma expressly reserves the right to argue that service of certain of these subpoenas may be defective as Sigma does not control some of the individuals identified in McWane's Subpoenas.

Accordingly, Sigma respectfully requests that this Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time be granted and that Sigma be given until April 6, 2012 to respond to the McWane Subpoenas *Duces Tecum* and *Ad Testificandum*.
